Dear Senator Bradley:

I am pleased to send you copies of the letters that I have written to Honorable Pope John Paul II and Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini. Both are dated March 15, 1988. The purpose of these letters is promotion of better communication and understanding among the national and religious leaders of the world, through creation of a cooperative movement and effort to end misunderstandings and conflicts that cause so much suffering.

In these letters I have described my experience with God and my inspiration from him, also my theories of existence, nature, evolution and gravitation. Furthermore, I have given some views in regard to making peace and happiness in the world, inviting them to cooperate with us, with God and all the world harmoniously, in order to make peace and happiness for everybody as God desires.

All of us should work together to heal the false, paradoxical and mistaken beliefs as well as superstitions which have perpetuated from generation to generation. They have caused paradoxical behaviors and attitudes in our judgements and in our dealings with each other and ourselves. Also they have made us trapped in the intermingled networks of confusions and conflicts within ourselves, our people, nations and in the world.

Dear Senator, in response to your permission to me to bring to your attention other information in regard to your consideration of legislative proposal in this area, I refer you to my letter to Mr. M.S. Gorbachev dated June 4, 1987 (copy is enclosed). As you notice, I have proposed to him the formation of the "Congress of the World" consisting of the spiritual and humanitarian leaders of the world in order to make proper decision, plan and action for peace, harmoniously as God desires. Utopia should be seen in the horizon for everybody.

We should be able to build the new humanity and civilization over the ruin of the past. If there is any virtue and any praise we should lead ourselves to them. We should think of whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just and whatsoever things are pure and lovely, including justice and fairness for everybody in harmony as God desires.

In my letter to Pope John Paul II, I have explored the "Time, its speed and its dimension" as they are in regard to their relations with us, with the universe, heaven and God. As I have explained in that letter, the dimension of time will become shorter in us if we move with a rapid speed such as the speed of light. If we exceed that speed and reach the speed of "Time," the dimension of time in us becomes zero (i.e., clock hands do not move ahead). If our speed is faster than the speed of time, then we can see time as a glob of crystal underneath us with all other matters in it (including our bodies). Also we can see God as a dense golden light "of thought" above us. The space between time and God is heaven. There is nothing above heaven except God.

Indeed, even though God himself lives everywhere in space, he has created the space through himself. Heaven has only two dimensions. They are distance and speed. There is no dimension of time in the heaven.

Also there is only one basic law which rules the universe in harmony.

My theory completely refutes the "Big Bang" theory in regard to creation of the universe. God himself has created the universe smoothly, peacefully, harmoniously and in an orderly fashion with proper plans and designs and a few simple rules, from non-existence and from himself (  $0 \rightarrow (+1) + (-1)$  ).

If there is anything true in regard to the theory of "Big Bang," it may be in reference to the theoretical explanation of the creation of God himself. Perhaps my theories, too, may be presented to the world in this fashion, at least on the cover of my book.
