Dear Mr. Williams;

Enclosed are copies of some of my writings and correspondences in regard to an inspiration that I had from God on July 3, 1986, and the theories that I have designed following that inspiration.

During the inspiration, I could discover the physical quality of God and also realized the reality of His existence. My theories are new theories of life and love as well as of God and His mind. They explain God, life, energy, matter continuum, and talk about the universe as an evolving, self conserving, self renewing existence which will always be able to support life through the power of God and His will.

The basis of the theories speak to the evolution of many schools of thought, such as psychology, religion, philosophy, modern mythology and others. They also address their potential powers for leading humanity toward achieving Health, Happiness and Harmony

I have summerized my philosophies in the letters I have written to Pope John Paul II on March 15, 1988, and to the former senator of New Jersey on April 5, 1988 (see enclosures). These letters were written after my desperate attempts had failed to make the Pope and other prominent world figures aware of the historical significance of my inspiration from God, as well as its potential power to ameliorate many human miseries. Without their proper attention, awareness and understanding, as well as their realization of their responsibilities and obligation toward God in this regard, the effectiveness of my position, my goals and efforts would have been endangered.

At this occasion, I would like to take the opportunity to express my sincere appreciation and deepest gratitude to Dr. E. Mark Stern, the professor in the graduate division of pastoral counseling at Iona College. Through him I could find emotional support and sympathy while I was in confrontation with hardships and suffering. He allowed me to continue to resist and fight for victory against many vicissitudes of life around me, even though he probably did not concur with some of the tasks I did. Through him I could realize that my thoughts, my writings, and my efforts have been within a collective conscience of reasons, logics, justification, human emotions and humanistic morality and values, especially when we consider their relationship with the truthfulness of the unique inspiration that I had from

God. Certainly my humanitarian and courageous actions were dedicated to God, and are to be used to improve the present and future life of mankind when they are prepared for it. They will be used to promote their capacity of understanding and attention to spiritual morality and values, and also to ameliorate their suffering and enable them to confront the realities of life with tolerance, honesty, truthfulness, true compassion and courage, instead of merely living within the fantasies of their mind.

Further clarificaton and elaboration of the many items written in my letters to the Pope and other distinguished personalities of the world, as well as my other actions will become necessary when the proper time arrives. Please feel free to contact me if further information is necessary.
